Tim Brimmer, D.A., is an Associate Professor of Music at Butler University and also serves as Director of Vocal Jazz Activities and Director of Multisensory Learning Facilities. His workshops and concerts for Butler students have included many music greats, including Elvis Costello, Marvin Hamlisch, Bobby McFerrin, and Manhattan Transfer. Dr. Brimmer is active in Butler's Study Abroad program, taking students overseas to perform. He is currently the Visiting Scholar at the Hong Kong Institute of Education, working with directors from several countries in preparation for the 2011 International Jazz Educators Conference while on sabbatical. Tim teaches graduate and undergraduate courses in choral music, digital arts, music education, and the honors program. He is leading discussions on the "neuroscience of music" with faculty from Butler, scientists from Lilly, physicians from the IU Medical Center, and colleagues in Asia. He is an expert at using technologies to advance teaching and learning in the arts and interdisciplinary curricula. Tim is currently designing resources and technological solutions for arts education organizations on three continents, often leading videoconferences with leaders from several countries simultaneously. He holds a Masters in Music Education from Northwestern Michigan University and a Doctor of Arts in Conducting and Voice Performance from Ball State University.
